ARCTIC MANOEUVRES.

At Fort Greeley, Alaska, units of the U.S. Army's Arctic training expedition fight wind and snow at 68 degrees below zero. Ten thousand G.I's are testing their equipment and themselves. Cargo planes parachute 400 tons of supplies to the ground forces.
