ARAB LEADERS MEET IN CAIRO  
(Nasraff coverage)  
Positive developed: 3 49 meters = 165 ft

The Arab "Big Three" ended the third session of their summit conference in Cairo yesterday and reportedly reached a final decision concerning Arab financial aid to Jordan to replace the British subsidy for support of the Arab Legion.

Saudi Arabia's King SAUD, Syria's President Shukri Kowatly and Egypt's Premier Gamal Abdel Nasser met behind closed doors in one of ex-King Farouk's private offices at Kubbeh Palace.

Each Arab leader was assisted by one of his top civilian advisers. These aids were Syria's Premier Said El Ghazal, Egypt's Foreign Minister Mahmoud Fawzi and Saudi Deputy Foreign Minister Sheik Yussef Yassin.

This coverage shows :

- Arrival of Premier Gamal Abdel NASSER at Almasa military airport to greet King Saud upon his arrival, in his private plane.
- shots of meeting of two leaders and their retinue, reviewing troops of honorary guard, made up of Egyptian Air Force men.
- Two leaders greeted by Arab diplomatic corps representatives and religious chiefs. Both stop to chat with Sheik El Tag Rector of Ashar and Haj el Amin El Hussein former Palestine Mufti.
- officials driving towards and to KUBBEH Palace where conference is taking place and all three Arab visitors are housed.
