Order and description of shots: Farade Ring. Prince Aly Ahan's "Royal Tan" (No.1) in parade. Roll 1. Ditto other horses in parade. c.u. Trainer Vincent O'Brien with jockey T. Taaffe. O'Brien, who trained the last 3 Grand Mational winners also has "Quare Times" entered but the horse sustained a bruised foot and could not run at Mass. See attached statement. T. Taaffe mounting "Royal Tan" held by Mr. 0'Brien. "Royal Tan" leaving parade ring. (Start covered by camera No.2) Field of runners coming around first time clearing two fences. (Outsider "Fly Along" leading the race) Field of horses coming up to finish clearing last two fences up to finish. "Amber Point" slips at fence and nearly comes down. L.S. of Stands.

Roll 2. Wrong start N.G. (Camera No.2)
Start of race.
Field of horses clearing fence.
Finish of race - "Fly Aleng" winner. "Royal Tan" is 6th.
Winning horses entering.
