A little before 6 a.m. the "Constitution" arrived into the port of Cannes. Miss Kelly was welcomed by the Mayor of Cannes. The "Constitution" left at 8 o'clock, sailing towards Monaco.

At 9H20, the ship arrived in view of Monte-Carlo, and at 9H30 entered the Principality's territorial waters. The "Constitution" began to pull up near the harbour entrance at 9H45.

The yacht Dec Juvante with Prince Rainier on board, accompanied by Count d'Allières, Chamberlain, and other officials of the Principality, started out towards the Constitution at 10H. At a quarter past ten, the Dec Juvante drew alongside the "Constitution". Miss Kelly then appeared, first going down the gangplank to the yacht's deck. She wore a blue dress and orchid given to her by the Mayor of Cannes. Then she went aboard the yacht and into the stateroom, followed by her parents and her sister.

The yacht steamed gently towards the harbour, while cannons boomed and planes dropped white carnations into the sea.

Miss Kelly stepped ashore, and drove with Prince Rainier through the streets of the Principality lined with a cheering crowd - after having received a bunch of flowers from a Monegasque child - to the pink and white granite castle.
