From 5.30 p.m. on on April 17. arrived at the
Palace high perched on Monaco rock, the foreign representatives of over
22 countries accredited in the small kingdom or representing their Governments.

The presentation of all personalities to the future
Princess of Monaco Grace Kelly, took place in the Green Drawing Room of the
Palace where Mr. Henri SOUM, State Minister, introduced to Prince Rainier and
Miss Kelly and their assembled families, the chiefs of delegations headed by
the Grand Chamberlain Comte d'Aillères.

Gifts are brought to Prince and Grace Kelly at Palace
April 17. 1956 in Palace courtyard
Pool coverage serviced to all competition
Positive developed; 60 meters - 200 ft

Over 150 press photographers, cameramen and newspapermen were admitted in the Palace Courtyard to see reception by Prince Rainier and Miss Kelly of the young french girl who won a competition made by Radio Monaco of the nicest letter written to the young couple on the occasion of their wedding.

Then Miss Grace Kelly is offered a white dove which she immediately sets free, but the dove only flies to the nearest white marble stair of the Palace. Among the splendid gifts offered the young couple Prince Rainier III is presented with a Roll Royce car by Monte Carlo people.
