The Duke of Minburgh comes to Bedford to imaggarate a new thousand-mile-an-hour wind tunnel, built ec-operatively by 14 of Britain's leading aircraft firms, One and three-quarter tons of air a second can be blem through the nine-foot-wide tunnel.

The Dake is shown a scale model of the installation, Three other tunnels are to be built - one of them even faster than this. The turnel is sealed ready for action, and the aircraft experts gather to hear a few words from the Duke before he presses the button:
