FRENCH PREMIER IN MOSCOW

Pool coverage serviced to all competition
DUPNEGATIVE DEVELOPED: 29 meters - 97 ft

For the first time since General de Gaulle's visit to USSR in December 1944, a French Government Prime Minister is going to Moscow, Later on Mr. Guy Mollet was to say: "we have come here to get better acquainted with you" to his soviet hosts

However the Prime Minister and his Foreign Minister, Mr. Christian Pineau made the trip also in an effort to dissipate misunderstandings disturbing international atmosphere, and they will do their best in the different exchange of conversations to seek new basis for a real appeasement in international tensions.

A short visit to the present Books Show organized in the "Maison du Livre" would, if there had been a need to do so, have shown Mr. Guy Mollet the importance of the French Culture in the everlasting research of international peace.

For four days, in the Kremlin as well as at the French Embassy numerous contacts between leaders of the two countries have been established to study the most important problems of today. An even though they did not succeed entirely in removing all divergences, they at least made a joint signed declaration in a very friendly atmosphere, and this opens the way to important cultural and commercial interchanges.
