#### C. E. A. Goes Conventional

Couple of angles of road, panning round to Mr. Davis's house. S.V. front

door. Milk, newspapers, on doorstep. Postman putting letters into letter box.

Couple angles on garden, spring flowers, etc.

G.V. Bedroom. Somebody asleep in bed, head covered up by sheet. C.U. Alarm clock about 8.am. (As clock starts to ring, hand comes out to stop alarm. Hand away, clock still ringing, hand back.) Sheet thrown back, person sits up. We see Mr. Davis for the first time. He rings bell. Breakfast is brought into the room on large tray. Sausages, toast, bacon, eggs, jam, tea, in fact the whole lot.

Mr. Davis starts eating his breakfast. Couple angle shots whilst eating and drinking tea, etc.

S.V. lounge. Mrs. Davis going round with a duster, dusting picture of husband and arranging flowers. Mr. Davis enters room dressed for business, says a few kind words to wife, kisses her and walks out of room.

Front of house. Chauffeur in foreground salutes Mr. Davis as he comes out of house and backs out of picture. Mr. Davis dressed in top hat and morning coat, etc. G.S.V. from road, showing drive and gate as Mr. Davis and chauffeur go to work on tandem. Chauffeur in front pedalling and Mr. Davis at back, sitting reading the Times, with air of travelling in Roils-Royce. Few angle shots en route, pedals etc. wheels, and Mr. Davis still reading Time. G. V. in Birmingham. Cycle coming up to cross-roads with policeman directing traffic. Policeman saluting Mr. Davis as they pass, as though this is an everyday occurrence. Mr. Davis acknowledges salute, continues to read paper. Dispuls Cips.

MIDNAMIN 028?

G.V. Conference Room. Birmingham. Delegates sitting round table, waiting for Mr. Davis; to discuss Blackpool Conference arrangements, etc. Shot of clock, 10 a.m. Mr. Davis enters. Conference starts. At this time, the camera should pan round table picking out different personalities, secretaries coming and going. If possible at this stage for a little side-play between delegates and secretaries. C.U. Clock 12.45 p.m. Mr. Davis gets up, all start leaving office for lunch. C.U. Mr. Davis giving secretary knowing glance. Secretary winks back as if to say "I understand, I will fix it."

S.V. Delegation walking down road. Mr. Davis with somebody leading and all talking shop. S.V. angles on pub. Pan round on to Mr. Davis and party about to enter. C.U. couple of delegates looking up atpub at each other with disgust at having to have lunch in a pub. S.V. party entering public bar, going up to counter. Delegates get on high stools at bar. Mr. Davis orders break & cheese and beer all round. Angle shot of delegates looking surprised at each other. Bar attendants putting bread and cheese and pickles on counter with beer. Pan from one delegate to another, registering bewilderment and whispering amongst themselves. C.U. Davis looking contented and looking at guests from left to right with slight smile on his face. Delegates start to drink beer. Woman puts head out of bar office, calls to Mr. Davis he is wanted on the phone. Davis gek just about to start drinking his beer, smiles, puts down his glass, gets off his stool, moves around behind bar and talks on telephone. (After short conversation he puts phone down, comes back to delegates, explains he is sorry he has urgent business and has to go back) B.V. Davis going out of bar. S.V. Delegates chin-wagging amongst themselves, still somewhat surprised, but now that they are alone seem to be perfectly happy. Call up for more beer.

Sound

Slip pan interior very posh restaurant. Mr. Davis sitting at table, bottle of wine, table-napkin tucked in at his collar, enjoying slap up lunch and apparently quite happyl With secretary. Waiter hands bill to Mr. Davis. Mr. Davis takes out notes. Waiter brings back one penny change on plate. C.U. Waiters face as Davis waves away penny change.

C.U. Office clock 3 p.m. G.V. Delegates seated round table. C.U'S delegates looking at wrist-watches and up at clock. C.U. Door opens. Mr. Davis walks in. Grin on his face, with a big fat cigar. S.V. Delegates looking at each other with knowing looks.

S.V. Name of Station is Birmingham. S.V. Railway carriages from Platform. Few scenes Davis and party boarding train.
C.U. Sign "BALCKPBOL" train pulling out of station.
