

5/26INDIANAPOLIS AUTO RACE:

Thirty-three drivers roar away from the start of the 500-mile Indianapolis Speedway Race - America's number one motor racing classic. Danger lurks round every bend in this gruelling contest, but although twelve cars meet disaster along the wreck-spattered course, by a miracle their drivers escape serious injury.

Speeds of up to 170 miles an hour are clocked on the brick and asphalt oval. And the winner, averaging 128, is Irishman Pat Flaherty, who has led for more than half the race but was only 30 seconds in front at the finish. He collects 75,000 dollars in prize money - plus a bonus from film star Virginia Mayo!
