BORAY RIOTS:

Ricting breaks out in Benbay, where the All-India Congress Committee India's ruling party - is in conference. The instigators are the
Mahrattas, and Prime Minister Nehru gives them the rough edge of his
tongue at a Congress rally. The Mahrattas are one of the main racial
groups in this large cosmopolitan city. They want Benbay included in
the new Maharashtra state, and they're saying so in no uncerthin terms.

When Nehru's government began forming new Indian states and merging various territories into bigger states, trouble was inevitable; for although India has to be organized, her hundreds of different communities make it a superinmen task,

Dosens of demonstrators are arrested as the rieting spreads. Nehru opposes the Mahrattas demand; he wants to retain Bombay, with its one and a half million population, under the Central Government's control. He strongly demonstrate rhots; such incidents he says, only bring India a bad name.
