Story ' BOMBAY DISTURBANCES REOCCUR WHILE
ALL INDIA CONGRESS COMITTEE MEETS

Once again Bombay the first city of India is in grip of disturbances. All India Congress Committee , which is the majority ruling party in India is holding its session in Bombay after 8 years and to synchronise with the holding of this session, it gave greater force to MAHARASHTRANS to vigorously enforce their claim for the inclusion of the ~~xxxxxxx~~ the city of Bombay in the MAHARASHTRA state. Although Bombay is a cosmopolitan city but mainly it comprises of the GUJRATIS and the MAHARASHTRIANS(or the MARHATTAS). Since the decision of forming new states and merging various territories in the bigger states, Maharashtrans have been raising their claim for the the inclusion of this first city in the Maharashtra state. Prime Minister Nehru has the opinion to keep this city under the control of the Central Government and as a result of that disturbances have been taking place in Bombay. The arrival of Nehru in Bombay and the holding of All India Congress Committee session gave a vigour to Maharashtrans and in defiance of the law they took out placards and raised slogans to include ~~xxxxx~~ Bombay in the new Maharashtra state. Thousands of policemen were working hard to keep the situation under control and many were ~~xxxxxxx~~ arrested for breaking the law. As the cars carrying important guests to the Congress Session passed , the hooligans raised slogans. Several times police had to use sticks in pushing the crowd and arresting those broke the law. Nehru while addressing the packed session of All India Congress Committee ~~was very angry with the~~ ~~hooligans~~ spoke against such manners and he said he could not tolerate such an insolence and he still had so much of vigour left in him that he could fight with such people singly. He further said that it was a shame that such incidents took place in India which bring bad name to this country.

Long shots of the crowd making disturbances near the Church Gate Station of Bombay. Shots of police arresting people and putting them in vans. Shot of Nehru sitting at the Congress Meeting in an angry mood Nehru speaking and disapproving of such bad manners.
