power plant like an eggshell, shearing away two-thirds
of the mighty generating station. The wreckage was hurled
into the deep Misgara gorge — two miles below Miggara Palls —
and buried under thousands of tons of rock.

The massive hydroelectric plant was thrown out of commission.

Power failed in Misgara Palls, M.Y. One man was swept to his death.

Water that once drove the turbines churns through the wreckage.

The water, undermining the rock structure, caused the disaster —
a loss estimated at one hundred million dellars.
