TITO VISITS COLLECTIVE FARM.

Marshal Tito's tour of the Soviet Union, where until recently he was Public Enemy Number One, is turning into a triumphal progress. Sometimes the welcome is literally overwhelming - and there are flowers enough and to spare, for Nikita Khrushchev and the other Government leaders escorting him.

Madame Tito is as popular as her husband. This typical welcome is at a collective farm in the Cosack village of Grigori-Polisskaya, near Stavropol, in the Caucasus. In these parts, it is traditional for a guest to be greeted by the elders with a gift of bread and salt. The gift symbolizes the end of the quarrel which the Russians leaders now admit, need never have happened.
