Rgyptian Premier Semal Abdel MASSER left Cairs by plane yesterday merning to reach PORTSAID on the Sues Canal where Emptian colors will be hoisted for the first time on NAVY HOUSE after British last troops left a few days ago.

Then on the dockside where stands NAVY 10USE, after a short rest with members of his Government Premier Nasser receives selemnly the Egyptian flag from the hands of an Egyptian Havy Officer. He kisses the flag and hoists it at the mast himself, while a 21-gan-fire salva salutes the first Egyptian flag to fly on the Canal Zome. Unities of the Egyptian Navy at anoher in the harbour are firing the salva.
