OCHET FATES TO MOSCOW.

Non-Stop to Moscow - 1,600 miles in four hours - flies an R.A.F. Transport Command Comet II, bearing important British visitors to the annual Soviet Air Force display,. The party is led by the Secretary of State for Air, Mr. Migel Birch, and includes Air Marshal Sir Harry Breadhurst, Bember Command Chief, and other senior Air Force efficers. The Comet has just come into service with the R.A.F., and this is her first operational flight.

Hever before have Western visitors been treated as honoured guests on Soviet Air Day - and to underline the change, the British party is welcomed by Marshal Ebigarev, Chief of Busala's Air Force.
