Britain's Peter Collins in a Ferrari won the 42nd French Grand Prix in Rheims, and an undisputed lead in this year's race for the world driving championship in a thrilling neck-and-neck finish with Italy's Eugenio Castellotti.

Castellotti straked his red Ferrari(NoI2) across the finish line a bare five seconds behind Collins. Third was Jean BEHRA, of France

in a Maserati (No4).

world chemion, Juan Manuel Fangio of Argentina was fourth also in a Ferrari (NoIO). He led for two thirds of the race, but lost out when his car needed a brief pit stop on the 40th lap of the 6I-lap

of the I9 cars that entered the race, only II finished. One of those forced out early with mechanical trouble was the first-post-war Bugatti, driven by Maurice Trintignant (No28); it was never a serious

contender and dropped out after 18 laps.

The officials credited Collins with a blistering average speed of I22.2 miles per hour for making the 314.5 mile race in 02:34:23.
4. Collins shattered the I954 record which Fangio set in a percedes

with the speed of II5.8 miles per hour.

In a preliminary race three record breaking JAGUARS (Nr.23 driven by Flochhart- H-Sanderson, No 24 driven by J.M. Hawthorn-Paul Prere. No 25 driven by J.D. Hamilton-Bues) fought a battle to sweep the top places in the Rheims 12-Hour international sports car race. The winning car was driven by Duncan Hamilton and Ivor Busb of

England (No25).
