COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES

Roll. 1.

Several L.S. Britannia lying at anchor in Rothesay Bay. Telephoto shots as Duke of Edinburgh boards Bluebottle. Series of shots as Bluebottle sails towards starting line accompanied by a motley flotilla of sight seers and Press. There is some minor excitement as two of these boats crash and also as a patrol boat comes alongside one of the yachts. I suggest that the theme here is the intense interest in the Duke's first racing appearance on the Clyde particularly as the occasion is the Centenary of the Royal Clyde Yacht Club. Shots of the start of the race - note that the Press and sight seers are now clear and the Duke is allowed to take a normal part in the race just as an ordinary competitor. General view of the starting and series of shots showing the rough conditions.

Roll. 2.

Note - Shot of competitor who has found the weather conditions rather extreme and has returned to moorings with a broken mast. the mast, even broken, has its normal attraction for the seagulls. Bluebottle, 192, rounding the mark at the end of the first lap. It may be seen that the Duke has outmaneuvered a fellow competitor and moved up from fifth to fourth place. Various shots as Bluebottle finishes, once again having a Press escort. General shot and reel run out of late finishers.

Note - At time of leaving Bluebottle's position in the race was not known but you will get that from the papers.
