LONDON HONOURS NISHBU AND HOLLAND,

The Lord Nayer of London and the Lady Neyeress, arrive at Guildhall followed by Mr. Mennies, Australian premier, Sir Anthony Eden and Lady Eden and other Commenwealth leaders including Canada's Mr. St. Learent. The eccasion - the conferring of the freedom of the City on Mr. Jamaharlal Mehru, premier of Iddia, (who arrives with his daughter Mrs. Indra Gandhi) and on New Zealand's prime minister Mr. Sidney Molland. Inside the historic meeting-place, the numbers of the Common Council are in seasion.

Mr. Holland and Mr. Nehru are enrolled as "citizens of London" by the City Chamberlain.

Thus the City gives to two more Commonwealth premiers the highest honour it has within its power to bestow.
