

LONDON HONOURS NEHRU AND HOLLAND.

The Lord Mayor of London and the Lady Mayoress, arrive at Guildhall followed by Mr. Mackies, Australian premier, Sir Anthony Eden and Lady Eden and other Commonwealth leaders including Canada's Mr. St. Laurent. The occasion - the conferring of the freedom of the City on Mr. Jawaharlal Nehru, premier of India, (who arrives with his daughter Mrs. Indra Gandhi) and on New Zealand's prime minister Mr. Sidney Holland. Inside the historic meeting-place, the members of the Common Council are in session.

Mr. Holland and Mr. Nehru are enrolled as "citizens of London" by the City Chamberlain.

Thus the City gives to two more Commonwealth premiers the highest honour it has within its power to bestow.
