OPEN GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP.

At Hoylake, the last round of the Open Championship is under way. Champion for the past two years is Peter Thomson, and he's all set for the hat trick. The 26-year-old Australian needs a round of 76 to retain the title, but neither bunkers nor a fresh breeze can put him off his game.

Thomson's only three strokes ahead of Florey Van Donck of Belgium, and for the first few holes it's tough and go. But Thomson's brilliant putting on the sixth and seventh, puts him in a strong position, and by the time he reaches the eighteenth green, he can sink it with three strokes in hand, and are the crowd pleased!

Peter Thomson's final aggregate breaks the record for a Hoylake Open by one stroke - and he's the first player for 74 years to win the Open three times running.
