

WORLD JUMPING FINALS.

Raimondo d'Inzeo of Italy puts up a fine performance in the finals of the world show-jumping championship at Aachen, Western Germany, after three days of eliminating heats. For the finals contest over this tricky course, the heat winners have to change their horses - and sometimes the change seems to be for the worse.

There's much disappointment that the reigning champion Hans Winkler of Germany, can't be here to defend his title; he was injured while earning his Olympic gold medal at Stockholm.

And the 1956 champion is Raimondo d'Inzeo with 64.83 points - nearly ten points ahead of his nearest rival.
