## PIPELINE FOR TRANSPORT OF MILK.

When on the neights of the Alps workmen laid down the first meters of a platic hose, there remained some doubt as to the issue of this new experiment: the first milk pipeline.

There where the woods are dense, the canalisation is aerial, but in the open air the pipeline is burried in a trench of 50 cms deep. The end of this original pipeline ist situated in St. martin, at the foot of the Rhône Valley. The works came to an end at the foot of the alps.
