### UNSINKABLE LIFE BOAT.

A modern Viking arrives in Margate on the first leg of his round-the-world trip - Captain Walther Westborg, skipper and crew of the Dana Rescuer, a new Danish lifeboat which is claimed to be unsinkable even if she turns right over. She's certainly an unusual sight, and quickly draws a crowd of onlookers to the quayside.

The Cabin is completely enclosed, and the steel-built hull can accommodate 20 people. The lifeboat is powered by a 4-cylinder British diesel engine.

Equipped with automatic-pilot steering gear and a two-way radio, the Dana Rescuer is as safe as man can make her. There's even an aircraft-type perspex dome for the helmsman. Her designer claims that she doesn't have to be lowered from a sinking ship - the crew simply climb into her, on deck, and she floats away as the ship goes down. What more can you ask?
