Britain has never built a bigger oil tanker than the Evgenia Klarchos. Her shaft horsepower is the greatest ever used on a single-screw merchant vessel, and she's three-quarters the length of the Queen Elizabeth. She's the tenth tanker of a 13 million pound order built by Vickers for Greek shipowner Stavros Klarchos. But Mr. Klarchos regrets that she will be the last, for Germany and Japan can produce them more cheaply and quickly.
