SUEZ WIVES RETURN.

Wives and families of British employees of the Suez Canal Company arrive at London Airport. Nearly all of them were sorry to leave Egypt, but while the crisis continues, the Company has strongly advised them to come home.

Another traveller brought back to London by the Suez emergency is Australia's premier Mr. Menzies. He's on his way to confer with Sir Anthony Eden before the big Suez conference assembles, but he pauses at the airport to give a few frank answers to questions:

REPORTER: "Mr. Menzies, why have you cut short your American visit?"

MENZIES: "Well, I had intended to go back to Australia via Japan and some other countries but of course, I've come back here because of the Suez Canal and the problems it presents, and the conference which is going to be held".

REPORTER: "What chance do you think the conference has of being a success?"

MENZIES: "I haven't the faintest idea!"

REPORTER: "What do you think of Russia's reply to the invitation to attend the conference?"

MENZIES: "Well I don't know whether I've seen it yet"

REPORTER: "Well briefly, it is that she thinks that Egypt is right in Nationalizing the Canal and that we shouldn't have taken the action that we have, but she is coming anyway"

MENZIES: "Well as usual, I find myself in disagreement with the Soviet Union. But plainly, Nasser's action was wrong in every conceivable way"....
