EVANGELIC CHURCH DAY 41,4 M

This year's Church Day in Frankfurt ended with a gigantic demonstration of 500 000 on the former airfield Robsbeck.

Prominent participants from all parts of the Christian world - 1,500 rank and file - 25,000 came from the Soviet Occupied Zone of Germany - also Herr Nuschke, deputy Ministerpresident of the Saxon Government (DDR). In the first row: also Foreign Minister Dr. von Brentano - Bishop Niemöller.

The high cross (with built-in loudspeakers ranging 5 miles) greeted the closing assembly.

Bishop Dibelius, President of the Evangelic Church, spoke prayers.

He entreated God to listen and give peace to the world and reunification to divided Germany!

The halfmillion community then sang the church-song "The Lord be thanked!"
