## VALIANT BOMBER WITH ROCKET TAKE-OFF.

Britain's four-jet atom bomber, the Vickers Valiant, can now take off like a fighter - thanks to rocket engines which can be slung under her wings. The recket unit is the De Havilland Super Sprite, the first British liquid-propellant rocket engine to pass the Official tests.

This medification means that the Valiant can use airfields which otherwise would have been useless to her. The Valiant bember corrying nuclear weapons has more hitting power than the whole of Bember Command at its peak war-time strength. And with the new rocket take-off, she is more efficient than ever.
