PART I 1-3 President Eisenhower provides the high point of the Republican National Convention as he arrives with Mamie in San Francisco. Never in its hundred year history has the GOP had a leader so overwhelmingly popular as Ike; and a huge throng at the airport bids him and the First Lady welcome!

PART II 1-4 Next day, in Cow Palace, the enthusiasm for Eisenhower reaches its climax. No other candidate is nominated for the Presidency. All states yield to Indiana, whose Representative Charles Halleck placed Ike's name before the convention.
