At Brookline, Mass., it's the Diamond Jubilee National Doubles Tennis championship - Australia's Low Hoad and Ken Rosewall crossing rackets with America's Vic Seixas and Hamilton Richardson. In the far court, Rosewall serves for the Aussies. The American's score as Richardson's lob drops in for the point.
