"SURVIVAL" tests off Lorient  
Roto coverage serviced to all competition  
Site: Off Loreint and Quiberon coast

Off the coasts from Quiberon in front of Lorient, famous Doctor BOMBARD who crossed the atlantic a few years ago on his raft the HERETIQUE to prove that crews lost at sea could survive a long time with proper food taken only from the sea in the toughest situation, made another test with the help of the French Navy specialists, called "SURVIVAL operation".

This experience included, after a last briefing at the Navy headquarters in Lorient in the morning, grouping Dr. Bombard, and Navy Doctor Aury, launching from an helicopter of a volunteer acting as lost at sea, and picking him up again with a string-ladder, to set him down on the waiting rescue ship "Rhinoceros"<sup>deck.</sup>

Then three big packages were launched from the 'Copter piloted by Lieutenant Colonel Curie, containing pneumatic rafts; Navy officer Soullier Doctor Bombard, Navy Doctor Aury jumped on board the rafts with other navy officers, engineers two representatives of commercial lines and two young women volunteers etc.. 24 persons in all.

After demonstration of rescue life-buoys, floating clothes and fluorescent liquid thrown on the water surface as a signal, the volunteers were left at sea to persue their survival experience, with sea-water for drinks and the Bombard techniques to get food from the sea.
