CELEBRATED SPORTSMEN GATHERED AT THE HEADQUARTERS
OF THE NATIONAL SPORTING CLUB IN LONDON TONIGHT TO PAY TRIBUTE TO
STANLEY MATTHEWS ON THE OCCASION OF HIS SILVER JUBILEE
IN PROFESSIONAL FOOTBALL.

IT IS NEARLY 27 YEARS SINCE MATTHEWS BEGAN MAKING HEADLINES AS THE BOY WONDER WHEN HE SIGNED FOR STOKE CITY AT THE AGE OF 15 TO WORK IN THE OFFICE FOR £1 PER WEEK.

ON HIS 17TH BIRTHDAY HE SIGNED AS A PROFESSIONAL, WAS CAPPED FOR ENGLAND AT 19 AND HAS SINCE ADDED ANOTHER 7.6 CAPS TO HIS COLLECTION.

THE SPORTSMEN ROSE AS ONE MAN TONIGHT TO MATTHEWS
WHEN, SPEAKING WITH EMOTION, HE THANKED THEM FOR THEIR RECEPTION.
HE WAS PRESENTED WITH A COCKTAIL CABINET COMPLETE WITH
DRINKS.

MATTHEWS SAID THERE WAS ONLY ONE WAY TO GET TO THE TOP IN FOOTBALL-BY BEING 100 PER CENT FIT.

"SKILL ALONE IS NOT ENOUGH"HE SAID. "YOU CAN BE
THE GREATEST BALL ARTIST IN THE WORLD BUT IF YOU ARE NOT FIT YOU
DONT HAVE A CHANCE. FITNESS GIVES YOU CONFIDENCE.
I DONT THINK ANY PLAYER SHOULD BE SATISFIED WITH A PARTICULAR PER
FORMANCE-HE SHOULD TRY TO DO ONE BETTER".
