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MILITARY TRANSPORT DEMONSTRATED.

Military transport, which stops at nothing is demonstrated to service chiefs and technical experts from many countries at the Ministry of Supply Fighting Vehicles Research Establishment, Chertsey. Underwater sport is getting so popular these days that some boffin was bound to think up a submarine Jeep. Only the exhaust and air intake are left sticking out - and, of course, any passenger who forgets to hold on tight. Never mind, sir, there'll be another one along in a few minutes.

Another feature of the demonstration is the suspension course, where vehicles are bounced mercilessly over several hundred yards of sleepers. Any springs which can stand this must be good.

But the Centurion's star turn is a swimming demonstration. A collapsible rubberised screen turns the tank into a boat at short notice.
