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BRITAIN v. HUNGARY ATHLETICS.

Britain's star athletes meet Hungary's top-liners in Budapest Stadium - and give their hosts quite a surprise. Heroines of the contest are the British women, who give their Hungarian opponents a thorough beating, by 70 points to 43. Our men lose narrowly by 104 points to 108, but some splendid performances by Chataway, Morris, Ibbotson and Dialley make it all worth while. The highlight of the whole meeting is the 5,000 metres. Sander Iharos of Hungary leads at the start, with Chris Chataway and Derek Ibbotson close on his heels.

Chataway running to plan bides his time - and keeps a weather eye open for Ibbotson. Iharos is setting a stiff pace - but he can't shake off the two Englishmen.

Three laps to go, and the Hungarian ace is beginning to tire. Chataway takes over the lead; and he looks as though he has plenty of strength in reserve. Inch by inch he pulls ahead - and how it's Derek Ibbotson, still lying third, who's waiting for his chance.

And there he goes; Ibbotson overtakes Iharos and Chataway! So far it's been a tactical race, with two Britons wearing Iharos down - but now it's the last lap, and the Hungarian's almost out of the running, and Ibbotson and Chataway are battling it out between them! Chataway makes a tremendous effort - and almost in the last yard he snatches a brilliant victory!

So Chris Chataway's back in Olympic form - in a big way!
