THE POZNAN TRIALS.

Trials against Hooligans and criminal eliments who, during the Poznan incidents, committed specific crimes, namely murders, violent attacks on institutes and state offices, soldiers and functionaries of the state properties, attacks on Militia stations, combined with the seizure of arms as well as cases of breaking into premises and pilfering public and private property, began at the VOIVODSHIP in Poznan.

In the Court Room No.100, the trial has begun of J. FOLTYNOWICK, K. ZUREK, J. SROKA. All are accused of beastial murder of Corporal Z. IZDEENY, a functionary of the Public Security Organs, as well as of taking part in specific stealing and attacks on public buildings.

In the Court Room No. 117, in the dock are: -

Z. URBANEK, J. POCZTOWY. S. JAWOREK. L. WIERZBICZI. L. PIOTROWSKI. S. KAUSMANN. L. OLEJNICZAK. J. SUWART. J. BIEGANSKI.

They are accused of stealing arms from the prison and (firing) at public Security functionaries during the Poznan incidents on June 28th.
