Four thousand miles away, at Tabora in Western Tanganyika, Princess Margaret meets the dansing warriers of the Wegogo tribe. No medness here; for 40,000 africans, this is a day of great rejeicing - and as the vigeur and excitement of the dansing builds up, Princess Margaret enters happily into the spirit of the coccasion,

Not only the warriors take part; tribal beauties help to mark the rhythm. There are dozens of different groups showing what they can do. Darkest Africa is anakening. Only a matter of time before rock and roll goes back to where it started.

These dances may be conturies old - but they can seldom have had such an appreciative audience!
