Austrian material in connection with Hungarian events.  
Dupenegative 67 meters : 224 ft

The Hungarian border close to Austria is about 200 kilometers from the Capital city of Budapest.

The Hungarian guards at the border after a day's without news from the capital decided to join the revolution, and after getting rid of their officers stripped their uniforms of Soviet Star, as well as the flags.

On the Austrian side everything was done to help, but precautions had to be taken. An Austrian jeep leaves for the Hungarian border to investigate. There the Hungarian guards have ripped their uniforms of the Red Star and are scratching it from everywhere. Hungarian soldiers have joined the revolt.

Red Cross ambulance arrives from the Hungarian side and Austrian people are doing their best to help by giving medical supplies and blood plasma badly needed for the wounded.

The Austrian Minister GRAF (Defense) arrives at the border for a personal investigation/

In the evening the first refugees cross the border and give first news to newspapermen.

Hungarian truck with national flags is let in, on the Austrian side, and immediately loaded with supplies before returning to Hungary. Hungarian soldiers arriving in Austria (without their red starred cap) are questioned/

NICKELSDORF, AUSTRO-HUNGARIAN BORDER. A HUNGARIAN AMBULANCE-CAR BEAT IT'S WAY THROUGH THE SOVIET BARRAGE AROUND BUDAPEST. THE CAR CAME THROUGH THE UNGUARDED AUSTRIAN BORDER (THE HUNGARIAN TROOPS WATCHING THE BODER IN THAT REGION ARE ON THE SIDE OF THE REVOLUTIONARIES) IN ORDER TO PICK UP BANDAGING MATERIALS, RESERVES FROM THE VIENNESE HOSPITAL'S BLOODBANK RESERVES AND ALL SORT OF MEDICINES SO BADLY NEEDED BY THE FREE FORCES FIGHTING AGAINST THE COMMUNIST GOVERNMENT AND THE SOVIET ARMY.

THE HUNGARIAN AMBULANCE WAS CHAUFFERED BY TWO MEMBERS OF THE REVOLUTIONARY FORCES WITH GREEN-WHITE-RED BADGES. WITH THEM CAME CIVILIANS WHO LEFT THEIR HOME IN TOWNS NEAR THE AUSTRIAN BORDER TO FIGHT WITH THEM AND STILL WEAR PLAIN STREET CLOTHES (ONE OF THEM IS SEEN WITH AN ARMFUL OF BANDAGING MATERIAL) TWO ARMY DOCTORS WHO DESERTED THEIR UNITS TO JOIN THE FIGHT FOR A FREE HUNGARIA CAME AS WELL, THEIR ARMY CAPS NO LONGER DONNED WITH THE RED SOVIET STAR. THESE MEN WERE WELCOMED BY AUSTRIAN RED-CROSS OFFICIALS AND VOLUNTEERS (ALL OF THEM WEARING THE RED CROSS UNIFORM AND CAPS) WHICH RUSHED DOWN FROM VIENNA WITH ALL THE MATERIALS NEEDED. AFTER A SHORT REST THE HUNGARIAN CAR SPEEDS BACK THROUGH THE UNGUARDED FRONTIER INTO THE DARKNESS AND WILL TRY TO REACH THE BUDAPEST REGION BEFORE DAWN.

THE THIRD SHIPMENT OF THE EVENTS ON THE AUSTRIAN-HUNGARIAN BORDER. - At  
SAINT GOTTHARD IN HUNGARY THE REVOLUTION CAME QUIET AND WITHOUT RESISTANCE.  
THE NEW HUNGARIAN FLAG WAS RAISED. - ON THE AUSTRIAN SIDE EVERYTHING WAS READY  
FOR A REFUGEE INVASION. - CHILDREN AND OLD PEOPLE WHO HAVE CROSSED THE BORDER  
INTO AUSTRIA WHERE GIVEN FOOD AND SHELTER. - EMPTY BUSES ARE WAITING FOR  
REFUGES. - MEANWHILE AT THE BORDER FACE HAS CHANGED CONSIDERABLY. - THE  
WATCHTOWERS ARE UNMANNED THE BORDER ITSELF OPEN. - HUNGARIAN SOLDIERS MINGLE  
WITH AUSTRIANS. - AT KLINGENBACH<sup>?</sup> THE AUSTRIAN AID FOR HUNGARY CONTINUES,  
TRUCKS ARE LOADED WITH MEDICINES AND PROVISIONS. - RED CROSS TRUCKS CROSS  
INTO HUNGARY.  
AT MAGYAROVER NOW IN THE HEAD OF THE REVOLUTIONARY THE COMMUNISTS HAVE SLAUGHTERED  
85 MEN WOMEN AND CHILDREN WITHOUT WARNING. FUNERAL OF THE VICTIMS - HUNGARIAN  
REVOLUTIONARY SOLDIERS ARE ~~NOT~~ STANDING GUARD. SMASHED CONCRETE <sup>SOVIET</sup> ~~COMMUNIST~~ STAR. -  
<sup>SOVIET</sup> ~~COMMUNIST~~ EMBLEMS ARE RIPPED OFF. CHEERING TOWNS PEOPLE.
