## NEWS FLASHES,

Whetislaw Germika, leader of Peland's struggle for independence, comes to the Kremlin to discuss with Soviet leaders the future relations between their two countries. Conscious of having succeeded where Hangary failed, Germika moets Khrushchev, Verenhalev, and Balgamin with a handful of aces. Through fear of Germany, Germika agrees that Russian treeps may stay in Peland - temperarily. But their movements will be subject to Pelish permission. A great victory in the struggle which is going on behind the iron cartain.

In the Venesualan espital of Caracas, sixty workers are trapped when a bridge under construction suddenly collapses. Four hundred tens of concrete and steel are deduced to rubble, and rescue squads work frantically to bring the injured to the surses and doctors who have been rushed from the city centre.

Jeining in the rescue work are police, firemen and civilian volunteers, But in spite of all their efforts, at least 14 people are dead and another 50 injured in the disaster. And the cost of the damage, to a project which was nearly completed, runs into hundreds of thousands of dellars.
