SKYSCRAPER FLATS.

New skyscraper flats are opened at Toryglen, Glasgow - and the first tenants receive a gift to mark the occasion. The flats were designed by L.N. Kresse, on the right, a German architect, for the Scottish Special Housing Association. The walls are slabs of non-reinforced concrete - only the floors are reinforced with steel. For all their comfort and finish, these thirty-flat blocks were built with the minimum of skilled labour.

Thermostatic control regulates the electrically-heated floors, and everything else is electric too. And the rent? Less than twenty-seven shillings a week!
