WELWEN TRAIN CRASH.

By a miracle, only one man was killed when this Aberdeen-to-London express crashed into the back of a local train near Welmyn Gerden City in the early norming mist, dereiling the last two coaches of the leval, Resour workers are quickly on the seens, expecting to find many casualties under the wreckage, but the roll of injured is only 26 out of 500 pessengers.

The one fatal easualty was 56-year-old Mr. Frank Clausell, of Welmyn Garden City, who was alone in the last compertment of the local train. Reports say a worse disaster was averted by the special "buck-eye" couplings with which both trains were fitted, and which prevent ecoches from telecooping. This stretch of line is equipped with the automatic train control system just approved by the Transport Minister - but the express was not modified to use it. The sooner it's universal - the better!
