BIGGEST EARTHEN DAM

Venezuela completes another vast project. This is the ultra-modern administration building for the huge \$65,000,000 Guarico dam and irrigation development. At dedication coromonies of the massive flood gate structure, President Jimenez watches the first waters flow down the spillway.

The water will flood two hundred and ninety miles of irrigation canals to turn an arid prairie of 300,000 acres into a farming paradise.

The nine-mile earthen dam creates a man-made lake, 94 square miles in area. A major project for Venezuela, using oil revenues to benefit the people.
