FIRE RUINS CATHEDRAL!

A disastrous fire sweeps through the Catholic Cathedral of St. Joseph at Hartford, Connecticut. Scores of firemen battle the blaze but it rages cut of control. Smoke billows a thousand feet into the air, flames engulfing the entire structure.

Before the battle ends, the edifice is a raging furnace.

Eight firemen are injured in this second Hartford church fire within 32 hours. And authorities say they suspect arson as the cause of a blaze that ruins the Cathedral at a loss of five million dollars.
