CHICAGO GRAIN FIRE,

A multi-million dellar blase rages out of control among Chicago's large grain elevators. Twenty-five fire brigades are almost helploss in the intense heat; they battle to keep the fire from spreading to other buildings, but the grain burns like timder.

Strong winds hamper the firemen operating hoses from the tall extension ladders. The full force of the pumps isn't emough to reach the blase.

Pirally the huge elevator collapses and one of Chicago's worst-over fires has caused a less of five million dollars in grain alone.
