WHO ELSE COVERED

Story: An exchange of prisoners between Israel and Egypt was held this morning in the presence of Representatives from the Red Cross and U.N.O. observers. Egypt has received some thousands of prisoners, captured during the campaign of Sinai, while Israel was handed 4 (four) prisoners, among which one only was captured during during the same campaign and the remainder three during Egyptian Patrols incursions in Israel territory. The parents of the four Israeli prisoners went to receive the latter.

ISRAEL RETURNS
EGYPTIAN POWs

The exchange of war prisoners between Egypt and Israel gets underway, but the traffic is mostly in one direction. The Israelis captures some 55 hundred Egyptians in the brief war, they're being returned in groups of five hundred each day.

Entering the neutral strip controlled by the United Nation's Force, Yugoslav troops in this section, the Egyptian soldiers are checked through by UN and Red Cross officials. With their papers in order, they're on their way home after two months of captivity. The return of Israeli POW's is simpler. Egypt only captured four.
