## TAFILAL ST.

Lidelt is a small town situated in South Morocco, at about 250 km. from Mekneswhen following the mountain paths. But owing to the bad weatherthere remained only the Boulemane pass which lenghtened the way by about 100 km.

Governor ADDI OU BIHI, knowing that the royal armed forces were preparing to come to Midelt in the night between the 21st. and 22nd. left with his partisans to hide at Kerranto where he has his home and which is situated at about 140 km. from Midelt. Owing to favorable circumstances 4 pressmen and I personally have been able to meet SI ADDI OU BIHI who gave us the reasons for the position he has taken. After having been accompanied up to the border of a " no manis land " during 20 kms. by an officer of the Royal armed Forces, we could get in contact with him and accompany him in his home guarded by about 2000 to 3000 of his partisans, well armed with modern rifles.

We were told that if things did not settle for him he would continue his route towards the South. We were practically staying on the Algero-moroccan border.

General Kettani went to see him in the afternoon ; we attended this interview and as a symbol the Berber tribesmen dropped their rifles and submachine guns.
