

HEARTS v. RANGERS.

Hearts playing from right to left, are at home to Rangers, in the fifth round of the Scottish F.A. Cup. It's the first time Hearts have defended the Cup in 50 years - and they're up against tough opposition in the Glasgow boys, who are soon on the offensive.

HIBERNIANS v. ABERDEEN
