Minister Lemaire visits Sahara oil wells. all competition Positive developed : 50 meters - 170 feet.

Mr. Lemaire, French Minister for Industry and Commerce is at present visiting the Sahara desert oil wells, to study the Government's plan to make further research and begin exploitation of the Algerian oil ressources.

Arriving by plane from Algiers Saturday, Mr. Maurice Lemaire who was accompanied by Mr.Robert Lecoste Minister-resident in Algeria, visited at OUARGLA, the G.M.I oil well where he witnessed the first gas spring in this manuax forage settlement.

After listening to details from engineers working on the large oil projects in this ar a, Mr.Lemaire continued his visit by another site (Mr.107) and witnessed another gas springing at Well Mr.105. At present oil is springing from six wells, and it is planned to make 150 more drillings in the same area.

Meanwhile researches are going on, and the hopes of large supplies of oil from the Sahara desert are rapidly rising to become a certainty for the years to come. In the face of recent oil shortage and crisis flue to the closing of the Sues Canal France is making great efforts towards a national production which would, with time, help in freeing her economy from a large part of her foreign supplies, at least it is hoped that it will help not having to rely entirely on Near East oil in the future.
