King Saoud of Arabia arrived at Rabat airport for talks with Moroccan leaders on Mediterranean and Arab problems.

He was met at the airport by Sultan Mohammed Ben Youssef of Morocco, Crown Prince Moulay Hassan, Premier SI BEKKAI and other members of the Moroccan Government.

En route from the airport the motorcade of modern glittering chrome-lined cars stopped for a centuries old Arabian custom at the Kasbah des Oudaias ancient market where King Saud was given the traditional welcoming gift of milk and dates. Then King Saud continued to the Sultan's summer residence at Dares Salaam 6 miles outside of Rabat where he will stay during his visit.
