STRANDING OF MS "VITTANGI"

On its way from Narvik to Antwerp with a cargo of iron-ore the 16500 ton Swedish ore-tankvessel "Vittangi" ranned aground on a sandbar near Flushing (South-West Holland). Because of a great crack in the ships hull the "Vittangi" has a big list to starboard. Soon the situation became so critical that the crew was ordered to leave the ship. In a hotel they wait for the things to come. Bad things most probably, because salvage-experts who board the ship now and then fear that the "Vittangi" will break in two, when the wind is gathering strength.
