GERMANY V. BRITAIN SWIMMING:

British and West German swimmers meet at Hildesheim for a two-day international match. This is the men's 200-metre crawl, with Williams of Britain and Blecker of Germany way ahead of the rest.

Underwater windows in the swimming pool give us a fish's-eye view of the climax as Williams wins by a tenth of a second. Next on the programme is the 200-metre butterfly race.

Horst Weber of Germany is a master of this strange dolphin-like stroke, and he forges ahead to build up a six seconds' lead over Symonds of Britain.

Weber wins comfortably setting up a new German national record - and the meeting ends with a points victory for Germany.
