There has been an earthquake in the Southern West of Turkey on the 24,25 April 1957 . The first tremour was slightly heard but all the people rushed into the streets. Although the second tremour was strong the people were out of their houses, and consequently few people were killed.

Eskihisar, Milas, Fethiye and Marmaris are the towns that suffered too much from tremours. In some places eighty per cent of the buildings have been damaged.

The Government soon sent the necessary equipment and helped to meet the need of the sufferers.

President Celal Bayar and the Prime Minister Adnan Menderes arrived at the tremour area and extended their help and interest to the people.
